(Contribute to increasing economic opportunity, self-reliance and livelihoods for women-led businesses, entrepreneurs, and their communities in the Republic of the Marshall Islands).

**Background:** Opij eo an IOM (International Organization for Migration) ilo an kobaļok wōt ippān opij eo an OCIT (Office of Commerce, Investment, and Tourism) rej kōpejjōk kanne application ñan jabdewōt ilo jukjukün pād ko, ro rej peejnej, im ro rekōnaan kajjioñ im rej itoklimo in bōk kuñaer ilo būrokūraam in ikijjeen tourism. Aō Kapijuknen ej juon būrokūraam ej jipañ ro rekōnaan kajutak juon aer peejnej ak kōļapļok peejnej in tourism eo aer ilo Majōl in. (The International Organization for Migration in partnership with the RMI Office of Commerce, Investment and Tourism (OCIT) are calling for expressions of interest from interested individuals, businesses and communities to participate in an exciting new innovative program for tourism. Ao Kapijuknen is a women-led domestic tourism program that offers support to those interested in starting or growing a business in tourism in the RMI. The second round of the program is now open to receive expressions of interest from any interested businesswomen across Majuro and the neighboring islands! Five beneficiaries will be selected to receive up to USD 15,000 each in seed funding as well as be provided with ongoing mentorship, training, sales support and promotion of their businesses in partnership with the Ao Kapijuknen program.)

(All EOI applications received through the prequalification process, and by the due date indicated in this public notice, will be evaluated by a Grant Review Committee (GRC) consisting of IOM project management as approved by Chief of Mission for IOM Micronesia. The committee will also be supported by OCIT tourism representatives who will conduct their own evaluation. Short-listed eligible EOI applications will then be notified of their selection and be invited to submit a full proposal through a Call for Grant Application (CGA). Short-listed applicants will also be asked to participate in feasibility assessment site visits, where the GRC and OCIT tourism team will travel to the proposed business destination/location as part of the assessment evaluated through a set of selection criteria and conducted using a grid score system. Five applications will then be selected as winners to receive a seed funding grant of up to USD 15,000 each as well as on going mentorship, training, sales and promotion of their businesses in partnership with the Ao Kapijuknen programme.)

(Identify as a female or male business owner, aspiring entrepreneur, or community representative. If you are a male, then you must partner with at least one other individual who is female.)
