

Laura Typhoon Memorial:

It is located on the western side of the island, Laura. The monument was built in commemoration of the victims who lost their lives in the 1918 typhoon that caused 200 casualties and widespread destruction.





Peace Park:

it is located passed the airport towards the western end of the island (Laura Village). This park was built to commemorate those who fought and died in the Pacific during the WWII.



Alele Museum:

It is located in Downtown, Majuro. Enjoy displays of original woven fish traps, clothing, tools, canoes, historic photos of Bravo testing in Bikini Atoll and more...

Tobolar Copra Processing Plant:


Visit & Experience how the main export 'copra' of the Marshalls is being processed and made into oil, soap, etc.
